

National Indigenous Teachers Day Act designates February 22nd of each year as "National Indigenous Teachers Day".



ELIGIBILITY

All students in Grade 11 and 12 who live or attend school in the federal riding of Edmonton Strathcona are eligible to submit an idea.

Entries can be submitted either individually or as a team of two. Only one entry per team will be considered.

Submissions must fall under federal jurisdiction or the federal government must play a role or share jurisdiction with other governments.

Who will benefit from this bill? How does your bill ensure inclusion of all people?

Implementation

How does your bill fall under federal jurisdiction?

What will it take to make this bill a reality?

THE PROCESS

MP McPherson and her team will review the submissions following the deadline on February 26, 2024 and contact all applicants.

Once the winner(s) has been selected, the winning idea will be sent to Legislative counsel for drafting as a Private Members Bill (PMB). After the draft bill is approved and certified by legislative counsel, MP McPherson will table the bill in the House of Commons.

MP McPherson's team will work with the winner(s) to organize travel arrangements and set up an itinerary for the tabling of the PMB and other activities.

The deadline for your application to be submitted is February 26th, 2024, 23:59.
